"These covers have made a big difference in covering our maize stack. In the past pukekos would make holes in the cover through autumn, we would put an extra cover over the stack but this made a great place for rats to spend the winter. By spring there would be wastage from rats and holes. The Geosmart cover has eliminated this problem altogether.

Covering the stack with Geosmart is quick and easy. We use 10 meter lengths rolled on a PVC tube, hang them from the tractor loader and back down the stack. One person can move the cover into place and with only a small amount of sand bags or tyres to hold it in place it takes half the time to cover a stack compared to a tradition cover.

We have been growing maize for almost 15 years. It has become a large part of our cow's winter and early spring diet. As the costs of growing and harvesting maize has increased considerably over that time low wastage has become a high priority. Up to this past winter our stack has been covered with an oxygen barrier layer and a heavy shade cloth with tyres laid over the entire surface. After the first year of Weka damage a large bird net was also slung over the top of the tyres. Damage from the birds continued to increase with more and more wastage each year. Winter/Spring 2023 we had our highest wastage. Weka had punched a large number of holes through the netting and down into our shade cover. Valuable time was spent ensuring spoiled maize was not included into the cow feed. Overall we probably wasted a considerable amount of maize.

A new solution was required. Googling – "maize stack covers" brought us to the Cosio website and their GeoSmart Cover. The cover was easily installed and due to its own weight no tyres were used making the stack covering process much less labour intensive. The Wekas made no attempt to punch their way into the stack and therefore 0% wastage due to birds. The Cosio Geosmart Cover has been a great investment saving a huge amount of time and money.
